JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought the grant of regular bail in a cross version case registered under Sections 307, 326, 323, 341 and 34 IPC in FIR No. 255, dated July 11, 2014 under Sections 302, 341, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Distt Sirsa.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the instant petition. However, he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to learned trial Court to conclude the trial within some specified period, as the accused is cooling his heels behind the bars almost for the last three years.

3. Undoubtedly, petitioner was arrested in this case on October 24, 2014 and after interrogation, he was remanded to the judicial custody.

Subsequently, on completion of investigation a report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C was presented. Since the date of arrest of the petitioner, he is suffering incarceration. No doubt most of the witnesses have already been examined but pendency of the trial for the last three years, is suggestive of the fact that it is going on at a snail pace. Thus, learned trial Court is directed to expedite and conclude the trial within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. At the same time, Superintendent of Police, Sirsa is directed to ensure the presence of witnesses in the Court, who remained to examine on the date(s) fixed by learned trial Court to facilitate the disposal of trial.

5. With the afore-said observations, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
