Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.61 dated 30.04.2017 under Section 302 read with Section 34 IPC as well as Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 28.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been admitted on bail. He states that the petitioner undertakes to appear on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the proceedings before the trial Court and shall face the trial in accordance with law.
