Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 02.07.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Sudhar, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He had neither received any payment for assuring any job to anybody nor there is any receipt regarding payment of the amount.

Learned State counsel submitted that, on the basis of investigation the petitioner was running an institute for giving training for recruitment in the Army, had entered into a deal to get employment to seven persons, against gratification of Rs.1,50,000/- each and against the said amount, six persons have paid, a sum of Rs.1,25,000/- each whereas one person had given 1,00,000/-. The petitioner, had also issued passing

certificates which were found to be forged on the basis of report

received from Army authority. It has also come in the investigation that the deal regarding payment was found recorded in the CD and there is no ground for granting bail to the petitioner, therefore, the present petition be dismissed.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature. The entire matter requires effective investigation. Thus, no case is made out for enlarging the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
