Petitioners sought quashing of FIR No.57 dated 30.03.2016 registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 379, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural and all other consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion, both the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Ilalaqa Magistrate on 23.11.2016 for getting their statements recorded in the context of genuineness of the compromise and in respect of other attending circumstances.

The Magistrate while submitting the report also pointed out that though statements of Baudin and Shaffi were recorded on the date fixed, but there was one more injured person namely Samudin, who was neither impleaded, nor brought before the Magistrate. The report was taken to be incomplete and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners sought time for impleading the said injured in the present case.

Thereafter application for impleading Samudin as respondent No.3 was allowed vide order dated 09.01.2017 and the case was adjourned for today after recording statement of the injured before the trial Court.

As per report submitted by the trial Court none appeared before it for recording their statement.

It appears that the parties are no more interested in getting the FIR quashed on the basis of compromise. The present petition is accordingly dismissed.
