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**SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.**

Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 260 dated 4.8.2017, under Sections 20/27A of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar, who was allegedly supplying sulpha to the main accused in this case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that nothing was recovered from the petitioner in this case; he is in custody since 5.8.2017 and trial of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail

Learned State counsel opposed the bail petition on the ground that the petitioner is in the trade of drugs and he had supplied the sulpha. There is one more case in which 100 grams of sulpha was recovered from the present petitioner and there is no ground for acceptance of the bail petition.

Having considered the above facts and the facts that the petitioner was not found to be in possession of any narcotics in the present

case; he was involved in another FIR No. 258 of the same date i.e. 4.8.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time. Further, without expressing anything on merits of this case, least that may not prejudice rights of either of the parties, the present petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The present petition stands disposed of.
