The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.79 dated 20.02.2016 under Sections 147/148/149/186/188/332/353/379-B/412/427/436/124-A IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused namely Subhash @ Kala, Jagbir @ Bittu, Vikas @ Vicky, Manjeet and Jitender have been granted regular bail by the trial Court, while accused Pardeep @ Lila had been granted regular bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 03.04.2017 passed in CRM No. M-43341 of 2016. He further contends that petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 02-½ months since his arrest on 27.08.2016.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Rajesh, states that 02 out of 56 prosecution witnesses have been examined and now the case is listed on 20.11.2017 before the trial Court for examination of remaining prosecution witnesses.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the co-accused have already been granted bail and the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 02-½ months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner namely Bablu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
