The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.129 dated 24.05.2017, registered under Sections 21, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 12.10.2017.

On instructions from the police officials, learned State counsel submits that one more case is pending under NDPS Act against the petitioner.

Allegations against the petitioner are that 20 gm. smack was recovered from him and that is non-commercial quantity.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 12.10.2017

is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.

The petitioner would file an undertaking to the trial Court that he will not commit the same or any other kind of offence in future and he is directed to report to the concerned Police Station on every Sunday, Monday and Wednesday between 11 am to 4 pm.
