Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35 dated 06.03.2017 under Section 420 IPC and Section 4 of Prize Chits & Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978, registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala.

Vakalatnama filed on behalf of complainant, is taken on record.

This Court, while passing order in CRM-M-19019-2017 titled as 'Harsha Aggarwal Versus The State of Punjab' decided on 28.08.2017, has already dismissed the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail.

The allegation against the petitioner is that she had a financial dealing with late Smt. Raj Rani Goyal, mother of the complainant, for the last 10-12 years. Said Raj Rani had to recover about ₹38 lakhs from the petitioner and her husband which were paid by her (mother of the complainant) after selling her plot, gold ornaments etc. She was induced by the petitioner and her husband to get more profit than the interest of the bank on this amount.

For the reasons stated in the order dated 28.08.2017 passed in CRM-M-19019-2017 (supra), this Court does not find any merit in the present petition and the same is accordingly, dismissed.
