The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 18th May, 2017, registered under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Custody certificate of the petitioner is placed on record.

Perused Chemical Analysis Report. The contraband recovered from the petitioner is marginally in excess of the commercial quantity. He is not reported to be involved in any other case whether under the NDPS Act or otherwise.

Considering the detention undergone by the present petitioner, namely Kanwaljit Singh alias Gola, he may now be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate concerned.
