Prayer made in the instant petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a NRI and apprehending threat to his life on account of the fact that respondents No.4 and 5 are trying to take forcibly possession of his house. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 with regard to his grievance. However, no action is taken so far.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Simranjeet Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction may be given to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar for deciding his representation dated 11.09.2017.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievance of the petitioner and disposed of the representation dated 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-2) within a period of six weeks' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
