The instant petition was preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.96 dated 30.04.2015 under Section 420 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka.

Since quashing of the FIR was sought on the basis of an alleged compromise having been effected between the parties, this Court while issuing notice of motion on 29.10.2015 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, Abohar on 3.12.2015 or any other date convenient to the court for recording of their statements in support of the compromise.

Placed on record is a report from the learned S.D.J.M., Abohar dated 5.12.2015 and a perusal of the same would reveal that neither the accused nor the complainant have put in appearance for recording of their statements.

Even today counsel for the petitioner has not come present. It may be noticed that even on the previous date of hearing i.e. 21.10.2016 none had caused representation on behalf of the petitioner.

The only inference that can be drawn is that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition. Same is, accordingly, dismissed.
