TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.27, dated 01.02.2012, under Sections 452/307/506/34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran and all proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of compromise which as per counsel has been effected between the parties.

Court has been apprised that in the trial that ensued, petitioners No.1 and 2 have already earned acquittal.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed qua petitioners No.1 & 2.

Insofar as petitioner No.3 is concerned, namely, Jaideep Singh S/o Gurbinderjit Singh, counsel would very fairly submit that having evaded the trial proceedings, he already stands declared as proclaimed offender.

Under such circumstances, this Court would not be inclined to entertain the petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing on

the basis of compromise at the hands of a person who already stands declared a proclaimed offender.

Petition dismissed qua petitioner No.3.
