This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail filed by Mohan Singh – petitioner, who was declared as proclaimed offender by the trial Court. He had approached the Court of Sessions for grant of pre-arrest bail but the same was dismissed vide order dated 14.03.2017.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and ratio of authority *Lavesh vs. State (NCT of Delhi) 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 240* wherein it was observed that when a person against whom a warrant had been issued had absconded or concealed himself in order to avoid execution of warrant and declared as a proclaimed offender in term of Section 82 of the Code is not entitled the relief of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, this petition cannot proceed further and is dismissed accordingly.

The petitioner may avail of the proper remedy available to him under the law, if so advised.
