The case of the petitioners is that they are major and have contracted marriage on 01.02.2017. The marriage certificate and photographs of marriage evidencing marriage have been placed on the file. It is alleged that they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 8. To seek redressal of their grievance, they have submitted representation dated 01.02.2017 (Annexure P5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Sharma, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice.

Without commenting on the age of the petitioners and validity of their marriage, directions are given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to decide the

representation of the petitioners (Annexure P5) within one month from today, keeping in view the threat perception of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that if any criminal case is pending against the petitioners then this order shall not debar the respondents from proceeding in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of.
