Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.238 dated 21.10.2016 under Sections 313, 452, 323, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Perused the reasons given in the following portion of the impugned judgment shows the factual scenario of the present case:-

“Her son Samman was playing with the other children in the street where the children had a quarrel. Vinod Kumar @ Dhanna son of Khushi Ram, Akram son of Vinod Kumar, Darshan son of Ram Sarup, Saajan son of Darshan and Fauji son of Shammi Gill all residents of Basti Bhatian, Ferozepur entered the house of Tania and started beating her son. When she tried to intervene, Vinod Kumar @ Dhanna kicked her in her stomach and others had caught hold of her from her hair and

thrown her on the floor and they started kicking her. Vinod Kumar sat on her and kept on giving her fist blows. The other accused also beat her. When her mother Parveen tried to intervene, she too was met with the same fate. She raised an alarm after which the accused fled from the spot. She became unconscious and was bleeding.

In that view of the matter, offence of the petitioner is serious in nature as the petitioner has behaved in very cruel manner with the lady.

Dismissed.
