Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.223 dated 05.09.2017 under Section 420 IPC, Sections 63, 64 of Copy Right Act and Sections 103/104 of the Trade Marks Act, registered at Police Station Patara Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 29.09.2017, the petitioner was granted *ad interim* bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to aforesaid order of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.09.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
