Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in FIR No. 39, dated 19.04.2015, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Momdot, District Ferozepur.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that only three prosecution witnesses remain to be examined which he undertakes would be examined within one month from the next date fixed before the trial court subject to the petitioner's cooperation.

In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage does not press the present petition. He, however, prays for the issuance of a direction to the trial court to expedite the final decision in the trial after the conclusion of the prosecution evidence.

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable and accordingly request the trial court to expedite the final decision on the trial after the conclusion of the prosecution evidence.

In case, the final decision on the trial is not taken within two months from the date of the conclusion of the prosecution evidence subject to the petitioner's cooperation, the petitioner will be entitled to renew his prayer for regular bail.
