The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.280 dated 20.06.2013 registered under Sections 302, 450, 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC read with Sections 34 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sonapat.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested on 28.02.2016 and is in jail since then. The trial has commenced and all the material witnesses have been examined by the prosecution.

I have seen deposition of the witnesses annexed with the present petition for regular bail. Perusal of the deposition shows that the witnesses have turned hostile and none of them have supported the prosecution case.

In that view of the matter, since the trial will take its own time, there is no point in detaining the petitioner in jail as under trial. In the result, I am inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Hence I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-36939 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
