Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.120 dated 08.09.2017 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no recovery has been effected from the possession of the petitioner.

However, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Billu Singh, submits that 84 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered in the case which the petitioner had thrown in a canal. Even otherwise, three more cases of similar nature are registered against the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.
