Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 28.05.2015 under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 03.10.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.
