Learned counsel, inter alia, contends that the allegations against the petitioners are that complainant's daughter-Anamika and Reena (petitioner No.2) have been taken by Prince and Abhishek (petitioner No.1) for the purpose of marriage. Thereafter, both the petitioners have solemnized marriage with the consent of their parents as per photographs (Annexures P-9 and P-10) and are living together as husband and wife. Now, the petitioners have been summoned by the trial Court on the ground that they had facilitated and carried out the offence of kidnapping of minor daughter of complainant.

Pursuant to the order dated 07.02.2017, petitioners had appeared before the trial Court on 20.02.2017 and their bail bonds were accepted by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the bail granted by the trial Court vide order dated 20.02.2017 is made absolute and the present petition is disposed of by giving direction to the petitioners that they will be bound by the terms and conditions as mentioned under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
