In FIR No.174 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Phase-1, SAS Nagar (Mohali), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail. This Court had made an order dated 24.10.2016 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

I have perused the order dated 24.10.2016. Petitioner has deposited an amount of ₹5,00,000/- for which he has produced the deposit receipt. A photocopy of the same is taken on record and is marked as 'X' for identification.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 24.10.2016 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
