This is a petition for pre-arrest bail moved by petitioner –
Gumukh Singh who had been declared a proclaimed offender by the Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and
ratio of authority *Lavesh vs. State (NCT of Delhi) 2012(4) RCR (Criminal)*
240 by the Apex Court wherein it was observed that when a person against
whom a warrant had been issued was absconding or concealing himself in
order to avoid execution of warrant and declared as a proclaimed offender in
term of Section 82 of the Code, he is not entitled the relief of anticipatory
bail, the petition is not maintainable.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court
immediately and in case of his doing so and moving an application for
regular bail that be decided preferably within a period of 2 weeks of its

filing by the trial Court.

The petition stands dismissed.
