1. Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner-Harpreet Kaur alias Bhundi, has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.26 dated 6.2.2017 registered under Sections 302, 307, 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 3 (1) (5) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Section 27, 30 of Arms Act and Section 120-B IPC, Section 3 (2) (5), 3 (1) (N) of SC/ST Act added later) at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

2. According to the prosecution, in the noon time on 6.2.2017, the petitioner accompanying 15-16 people, attacked the complainant party by entering into their house and caused injuries to them. As a result thereof, one of the complainant-party, namely, Surjit Singh died on receipt of fire arm injuries at the hands of accused party.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had only accompanied her accomplice empty handed. No role has been attributed to the petitioner. Co-accused Judgepreet Singh alias Judge has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 27.9.2017 in CRM-M-33123 of 2017.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, but without expressing any opinion on the merits and also that conclusion of the trial may take time, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner-Harpreet Kaur alias Bhundi, is ordered to be released on bail pending trial, subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
