The instant petition was preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.37 dated 05.06.2016, registered under Sections 451, 323, 506, 148 and 149, registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

Since quashing was sought on the basis of compromise, parties were directed to have their statements recorded on 18.01.2017 before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned, in support of the compromise.

Placed on record, is a report dated 17.02.2017 of the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Malerkotla and a perusal thereof, would reveal that the parties did not appear on 18.01.2017 for recording of their statements.

Subsequently, notice has been issued for the parties to appear on 14.02.2017 and even on such date, complainant chose not to appear.

Under such factual position, instant petition seeking quashing of the impugned FIR solely on the basis of compromise cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
