Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 518 dated 13.8.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 364, 452 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sonipat City, on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 submit that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court for recording of statements. Pursuant thereto, now, there is a report from learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonapat stating that the statements have been recorded and the compromise is voluntarily without any pressure.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. FIR No. 518

dated 13.8.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 364, 452 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sonipat City along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
