This is the second petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.174 dated 4.7.2015 under sections 21, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was of 110 grams of contraband.

It has gone uncontroverted that as per report of the Chemical Examiner the contraband was found to be containing Alprazolam. 110 grams of such contraband would be construed as commercial quantity.

The first petition preferred by the petitioner in this Court seeking concession of pre-arrest bail i.e. CRM No. M-1353 of 2017 had been dismissed as not pressed on 23.1.2017 upon recording a statement of the counsel that the petitioner would duly surrender and thereafter file an application seeking regular bail.

Petitioner has chosen not to surrender.

Conduct of the petitioner disentitles her from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
