In this petition, the petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in F.I.R. 69, dated 19.05.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 427, 341, 506 and 379-B of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 323 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code added later on), registered at Police Station Khizrabad.
