Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR, which has been lodged by the brother-in-law of the petitioner, are that it was at the instance of the petitioner that co-accused had hit the complainant with their car, as a result of which, he suffered injuries. Learned counsel further contends that although the occurrence is stated to have taken place on 19.08.2015, the FIR was registered after a delay of sixteen days i.e. on 05.09.2015. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted anticipatory bail by this Court but she could not appear before the trial Court on two dates as she was unwell and, therefore, her bail bonds were cancelled. He also states that the petitioner, who is a lady with three minor children, is in custody for over 05 months.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner, which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for over 05 months. He upon instructions from HC Baljinder Singh, further states that the investigation has been completed and the challan was filed in the Court on 06.08.2017.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner being a lady with three minor children has been in custody for over 05 months and the investigation has been completed, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Davinder Kaur @ Rani is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
