The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail in FIR No.0186 dated 04.08.2017, registered under Sections 354, 365, 341, 323 and 148 read with Sections 149 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Patran, District Patiala.

Contends that the petitioner and the sister of the complainant had a love affair. The matter has been compromised between the parties vide compromise, Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the complainant admits the factum of compromise and states that he would have no objection, in case, the instant petition is allowed.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties vide compromise, Annexure P-1, without advertng to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The

petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, anything noticed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
