Petitioners-Kulwinder Singh and Harwinder Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.178 dated 07.09.2017, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners stated that the petitioners have already deposited the amount as per the order dated 30.10.2017 passed by this Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that the petitioners have already joined the investigation; they are not required for custodial interrogation and, therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody. Finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 30.10.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
