The petitioners have approached this Court challenging the acquisition of land, where notifications under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, 'the Act') were issued on 21.5.2004 and 6.4.2005, respectively.

Learned counsel for the respondents produced in Court notification dated 13.7.2007 issued under Section 48 (1) of the Act and submitted that the land owned by the petitioners, which was acquired, has been de-notified.

Considering the aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents, the prayer made in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly the petition stands dismissed.
