This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 89 of 28.06.2016 registered under Section 406/498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar on the basis of compromise reached between the parties.

A copy of the compromise has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-3. In terms of the said compromise, parties have decided to dissolve their marriage under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, subject to payment of Rs. 2,50,000/- as permanent alimony, to the wife.

I have been informed that the said petition has already been filed and a sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- has been paid at the stage of first motion statement.

Notice of motion was issued in this petition vide order dated 04.10.2017 and the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court. Pursuant to the said order, report dated 11.10.2017, has been received

from the trial Court, according to which the compromise, arrived at between the parties is genuine and statements of the parties have been recorded.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the FIR No. 89 of 28.06.2016 registered under Section 406/498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar and consequent proceedings thereunder, are hereby quashed. The parties shall abide by the terms of the compromise.
