The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 59 dated 25.05.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kathunagal, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he has caused two injuries on the hand and leg of the complainant with Dattar and the injury on the leg was found to be grievous in nature. It was further contended that there was delay of 3 days in registration of the FIR and even the MLR of the injured was prepared after one day.

This Court vide order dated 01.11.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the

conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ajit Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 01.11.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 01.11.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
