Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.149 dated 31.05.2017 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Bahadur Lal, states that there are as many as five other cases against the petitioner and incidentally, all the cases are under NDPS Act. The details of cases registered against the petitioner, is as under:-

- “i) FIR No.183 dated 28.10.1993 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, Police Station Nakodar.
- ii) FIR No.115 dated 06.04.2006 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, Police Station Nakodar.
- iii) FIR No.66 dated 11.06.2012 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, Police Station Machhiwara, District Ludhiana.

- iv) FIR No.110 dated 22.04.2013 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar, Nakodar.
- v) FIR No.91 dated 17.04.2015 under Sections 15, 18, 21, 22 of NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar, Nakodar.”

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
