The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.92 dated 05.10.2016 for the offence under Sections 376(2)(n), 389, 450, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Petitioner is in custody since 08.10.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that prior to registration of this FIR, a complaint was made on 19.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) and as per report (Annexure P-3) petitioner was found to be innocent. He further submits that complainant in her statement (Annexure P-4) and her cross-examination (Annexure P-5) made statement that petitioner is innocent.

Learned counsel for the State submits that out of total 20 witnesses, 8 has been examined along with prosecutrix/complainant.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is likely to take time for its own conclusion in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, Bhiwani.
