The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.485 dated 13.8.2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal.

Heard.

The matter has since been amicably settled in the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. As per settlement, the petitioner has already paid a sum of ₹ 3 lacs tot he complainant vide demand draft No.608726 dated 18.1.2017 and he has to pay ₹ 2 lacs on 25.4.2017, ₹ 3

lacs on 25.6.2017 and another sum of ₹ 2 lacs on 25.8.2017.

As the matter has been amicably settled, order dated 22.12.2016 allowing interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the terms of settlement. In the event of the petitioner not paying ₹ 2 lacs on 25.4.2017, bail allowed shall be deemed as cancelled and he will surrender in Court and shall be taken in custody. In the event of the payment of ₹ 2 lacs being made on 25.4.2017, above term will apply for the remaining payments.
