Petitioner-Anshul Chug has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.205 dated 25.11.2015, registered at Police Station Division No.6, Industrial Area, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner has already joined the

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investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation. Furthermore, parties have already effected compromise and copy of the same has been placed on record as Annexure P-2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has also stated that petition for quashing of the aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise has already been filed and the same is pending before this Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 24.10.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
