This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.837, dated 29.07.2016 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Chandi Bagh, Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and handed over the details of the cheque to the Investigating Officer.

This fact is not disputed by the learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.10.2016, is made absolute.

However, it is made clear that before submitting the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., in case, the petitioner is still required for further investigation, the Investigating Officer may direct the petitioner by issuing a notice to rejoin the investigation.
