The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0237 dated 02.09.2017 under Sections 380/457 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had purchased the stolen property.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 04.10.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Leelu Ram, states that in pursuance to the order dated 04.10.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 04.10.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
