This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 61 dated 24.02.2016 registered at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 188, 121, 323, 325, 307, 427 and 436 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court, submits that the process for proclamation to declare the petitioner a proclaimed person has already been initiated by the trial Court and as such, at this stage, he would not be entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that upon the petitioner surrendering himself and making an application for regular bail, the said application be directed to be decided expeditiously.

Consequently, while dismissing this petition, the aforesaid directions are issued to the learned trial Court, to decide the bail application for regular bail, if any is made by the petitioner upon surrendering before that Court, as expeditiously as possible, on its merits.
