The instant petition under Section 439 Cr. P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR no. 40 dated 17.02.2017, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this matter and has been in custody since 02.04.2017. In fact the main accused Jasvir Singh, who had already been granted interim bail by this Court in CRM-M-37772-2017 titled as 'Gurjit Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and Another'. It has also been stated that the matter has been compromised between the parties in the said FIR and on this ground he would be entitled for grant of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent vehemently opposes the

grant of regular bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the main accused Jasvir Singh had been allowed interim bail, there would be no useful purpose for keeping the petitioner incarcerated and since the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
