This petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.1 dated 04.01.2017 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

Contentends that all the necessary documents have already been recovered and the co-accused have already been enlarged on regular bail. He further contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the case file.

This is a second bail petition. The first petition for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed, vide order dated 08.05.2017. The bail petition filed by the co-accused and their subsequent release cannot be said to be any favourable circumstance in favour of the petitioner.

This Court feels that it is a fit case where custodial interrogation

of the petitioner is required to unearth the truth.

Consequently, bail application stands dismissed.

Anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
