The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.148 dated 08.06.2017, registered under Sections 22/61/85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, (for short, 'the NDPS') at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

Custody certificate of the petitioner placed on record. He has remained in detention for over four months now.

Admittedly, the recovery of contraband from him was just about the commercial limit and he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

For the above-said reasons, the present petitioner, namely Harpreet Singh @ Gaggu is released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Area Magistrate at this stage considering the same detention undergone.
