Through the present petition, quashing of FIR No.79 dated 01.08.2014, registered under Sections 323/452/341/506/148/149 IPC, at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, is sought for on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Through order of this Court dated 27.10.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court to get their statements recorded, who in turn was directed to send a report to this Court as also to apprise this Court the number of persons involved in the present FIR and if any of them has been declared proclaimed offender.

As directed, report dated 10.01.2017 from the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, has been received, as per which the parties recorded their statements before the trial Court in terms of the

offender.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance to the afore-referred FIR would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others versus State of Haryana and others, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I deem it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.79 dated 01.08.2014, registered under Sections 323/452/341/506/148/149 IPC, at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, and all proceedings arising therefrom.
