Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.62 dated 21.05.2017 under Section 15 NDPS Act and Sections 27A, 29 and 25 NDPS (added later on) registered at Police Station Behal, District Bhiwani.

The aforesaid FIR was registered on account of recovery of 1505 kgs. of *chura post* from the house of co-accused Krishan. As per the case of the prosecution, co-accused namely Anil and Kanwar

Pal have named the petitioner in the case, wherein they have admitted that the petitioner was also involved in the present case.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that huge quantity of contraband was recovered in the case and the petitioner has been specifically named by co-accused namely Anil and Kanwar Pal, no ground for regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.
