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**JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)**

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.170, dated 11.09.2016, registered under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 10 of Immigration Act, at Police Station Chhappar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The learned Senior counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 26.10.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation. He states that no role has been attributed to the petitioners and nothing has been recovered from them.

Reply on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in the Court, same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation. He states that compromise has been effected between the parties.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.10.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
