Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.127 dated 08.09.2017 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 06.10.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 06.10.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
