APS/53876/23.09.11 and APS/17081/2013/23.09.11;
challenging the summoning order dated 08.10.2011
passed by the trial Court in a complaint filed under
Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and the
order dated 13.12.2012 (Annexure P3) vide which the
petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.*

*Perusal of the order dated 12.07.2016 passed by
this Court would reveal that the case is fixed for service
of respondent No.2 and no serious efforts are made by
the petitioner for effecting service upon respondent
No.2.*
