Report dated 20.12.2016 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Manmeet Kaur as well as of complainant Natho Wati, it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR**

Criminal 543 and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.76 dated 20.08.2016 under Sections 365 IPC (subsequently added Section 374 IPC), Police Station, Phase VIII, Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
